

History in the Making, Gettysburg & York

Sept 24-27, 2018



York County Pennsylvania, is the Factory Tour Capital of the World. From motorcycles to potato chips, York County offers a glimpse behind the scenes of the making of some of America's favorite products. Additionally, York County is a great place to explore the rich history of Pennsylvania & the United States. The first capital of the U.S., York provides a number of unique museums and historic sites, including a replica of the Colonial Courthouse where the Continental Congress met to ratify the Articles of Confederation during their 9-month stay in the region.

Gettysburg National Battlefield, site of a turning point in the Civil War, now part of Gettysburg National Military Park. The park also includes the Gettysburg Museum and Visitor Center, displaying Civil War artifacts, and Gettysburg National Cemetery, where a memorial marks the site of Abraham Lincoln's 1863 Gettysburg Address.

Day 1 - Monday, Sept 24, 2018

You'll travel by motorcoach to York, Pennsylvania. On the way, you'll stop at the **"Flight 93 National Memorial, A common field one day. A field of honor forever."** One of America's newest memorials, The Tower of Voices, is conceived as a monumental, 93 feet tall musical instrument holding forty wind chimes.

Afterwards, lunch will be on your own, before checking into the **Heritage Hills Resort** in York, PA. **(Dinner)**



Day 2 - Tuesday, Sept 25, 2018

Today's experiences start with the **Harley Davidson Motor Company Vehicle Operations**. This factory tour offers a behind-the-scenes look at the making of a legend. See first-hand how these legendary machines come to life and take a look at the manufacturing and assembly processes.



Next, you will experience “**Turkey Hill Dairy.**” Have you ever wondered why ice cream tastes so good? You'll find out at this 26,000 square foot dairy tour.

Turkey Hill is famous for its ice cream and iced tea making processes. You will experience interactive exhibits



(including a chance to make your own ice cream flavor), a café, a gift shop, and other fun activities for the entire group!



After lunch on your own at the **City Market** and tour of historical York, you will visit the **Bluett Bros Violins** where Mark, the owner, will walk you through the process of crafting a violin; from choosing the wood, carving, and tap toning to the finishing process. Learn about the correlation of stringed instruments throughout history as well as the acoustic properties that connects each genre of music. The last stop today will be the **Stauffer's Factory Outlet Store**. Known worldwide for their Animal Crackers and cookies, Stauffer's Outlet offers a wide variety of other cookies, candies and salty treats delighting shoppers with every visit. **(Breakfast)**



Day 3 - Wednesday, Sept 26, 2018

Today's experience is **Gettysburg's National Military Park and Battlefield!** At the Gettysburg National Park Museum you will enjoy the film, cyclorama painting and museum before an included lunch at the **Dobbin House**. After lunch,



a local guide will join the group for a battlefield tour.
