Day One, Wednesday, May 7, 2025: Depart Home.



Kylemore is home to a community of nuns of the Benedictine Order who came here in 1920 after their abbey in Ypres, Belgium

was destroyed in World War I. Settling at Kylemore, the Benedictine Community opened a worldrenowned boarding school for girls and began restoring the Abbey, Gothic Church and Victorian Walled Garden to their former glory. Departing Kylemore we travel to Donegal and check into the Lough Eske Castle Hotel for a two-night stay.
