After checking into our hotel we'll enjoy dinner and a show at the Gandy Dancer Theater, West Virginia's ONLY Branson – style dinner theater. This theater which is nestled in the heart of the WV mountains, features music from the 50's to present day, country, gospel, rock and roll as well as patriotic. (Dinner)

Day Two: Tuesday, Oct 19, 2021

This morning we reach for the stars at the Green Bank Observatory, an astronomical observatory with the world's largest steerable radio telescope, located in the National Radio Quiet Zone in Green Bank, West Virginia.
