### Day One – Thursday, December 4, 2025 – Williamsburg Embassy Suites

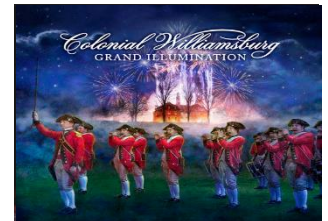
### Day Three – Saturday, December 6, 2025 – Williamsburg Embassy Suites
